
RE: Watertown Tire Recyclers - Fire control action plan

Dear Mr. Butts:

Our office had issued a permit for the tire shredding facility at the Watertown Tire Recycling plant located at W7932 Provimi Road, Section 25, Town of Shields. One of the conditions placed on this permit was that an agreement was to be worked out between the owner and the Watertown Fire Department regarding fire department assistance in fighting fires on the premises. Said agreement was also required to be recorded with the Dodge County Register of Deeds. In reviewing our records, our office had received a letter from Fire Chief - Richard Olsen, dated September 10, 1997 (copy enclosed) that was considered the "action plan" in the event of a fire on this property. Our office does not, however, have any record that this plan or any other agreement between your department and Mr. Springer was ever recorded with the Register of Deeds.

Prior to our office recording the September 10, 1997 letter by Mr. Olsen, I would like to determine if this "action plan" is still considered the appropriate response that will be taken by your department and the owner in the event a fire would occur at this facility. Would you please review the enclosed letter and give me thoughts on whether a revised "plan of action" for fighting a fire at this site is needed to adequately protect the area. Any information that you could give me regarding this issue would be greatly appreciated. If you have any questions, please feel free to give me a call. Thank you for your assistance with this matter.
